Bitches in season may run in the last brace of the day only if entered in the last stake of the day ran on the course. AKC-approved tracking collars will be permitted.

The Field Trial Committee reserves the right to cancel a stake with less than four entries and to rearrange the running order if necessary.

**Amateur Gun Dog (AGD), Amateur Limited Gun Dog (ALGD), Open Gun Dog (OGD), and Open Limited Gun Dog (OLGD)** stakes are retrieving stakes that are open to all pointing breed dogs 6 months of age and over on July 31, 2010. AGD, ALGD, OGD and OLGD will run 30-minute braces.

**Open Derby (OD)** is open to all pointing breed dogs 6 months of age and under 2 years of age on July 31, 2010. OD will run 20-minute braces.

**Amateur Puppy (AP) and Open Puppy (OP)** stakes are open to all pointing breed dogs 6 months of age and under 15 months of age on July 31, 2010. AP and OP will run 15-minute braces.

**Hunter's Amateur Gun Dog** is a TEVCO special event and is open to Vizslas only that are 6 months of age and over on July 31, 2010 that do not hold AKC Master Hunter, Field Champion or Amateur Field Champion titles. The stake is non-retrieving and will run 20-minute braces. The dogs will be run in braces unless a written request to run a dog individually is received by the Field Events Secretary prior to the closing date.

**\*This Walking Field Trial is being held in conjunction with Junior Hunt Tests that will run on Course 2 on July 31, 2010 and August 1, 2010. The AP and OP stakes will follow the Junior Hunt Test on each day. See separate premium for more information on the Junior Hunt Tests.**

## COURSES AND BIRDS

All stakes are single course without a bird field. Chukar, pheasant, and/or quail will be released in all stakes except AP and OP. A blank cartridge will be fired on any bird contact in all stakes except AP and OP.

AGD, ALGD, OGD and OLGD stakes are retrieving stakes. Dogs in contention will be called back for a retrieve. Blaze orange must be worn during call backs for retrieves.

Horseback handling will not be permitted. Only judges, bird planters and marshals may be mounted.

## PRIZES

Standard AKC rosettes will be awarded to all placed dogs. A trophy will be awarded to the dog that places first in Hunter's Amateur Gun Dog.

Potable water is not available on the grounds. Bring your own drinking water for you and your dog(s). Overnight camping is not permitted. Please pick up all dog droppings around the check-in and food tent areas.

## DIRECTIONS TO SAUVIE ISLAND

Take Highway 30 west from Portland to Sauvie Island. Turn right from Highway 30 at NW Sauvie Island Road and cross the bridge over the Willamette Slough. When you come off the bridge, stay right and follow the road past the little store on the left and continue on NW Sauvie Island Road. When you come to a "Y", keep to the left and keep going. You will pass a sign letting you know you are on the West Units. The road will eventually turn into a dirt road; you will cross two cattle guards and then make a sharp right turn remaining on the dirt road. Keep following this road until you see our camp (on the left). If you have reached the river, you have gone too far. Parking permits are required on the Island. They are available for day only or yearly use.
